

Rules for submitting articles

1. Articles proposed for publication in the journal "Problems of Atomic Science and Technology. Series: Physics of Nuclear Reactors":

- cannot be previously published in other publications or simultaneously sent for publication to other journals;

- shall be drawn up in accordance with established rules;

- shall have permission to publish openly.

2. The rules for article formatting are published in each issue of the journal and are posted on the journal's website.

3. All documents in electronic form are sent to the name of one of the deputy editors-in-chief:

- a manuscript file drawn up according to the rules for formatting articles;

- figures in separate files in jpg, tif format with a resolution of at least 300 dpi;

- a copy of the permission for open publication of the article.

4. The editorial board may reject a text before its formal review if it considers it to be inconsistent with the format or content of the journal, or if it receives information that the article text has been published in whole or in part, or is under consideration by another publisher.

5. If a decision is made to publish the article in the journal, a license agreement is concluded with all the authors of the article to grant the publisher the right to publish the article and place it in the information and analytical systems.
