

**Manuscript preparation rules for the journal Problems of Atomic Science and Technology, ser. Thermonuclear Fusion (PAS&T/TF)**

The editorial staff is asking the authors be guided by the following directions under preparation of the manuscripts for publication in the journal:

the text with the UDC (universal decimal classification) number, abstract with key words, illustrations, captions, data on the authors (photos, surname, first name, patronymic, position, academic degree and rank, mailing and e-mail addresses, and contact phone number) are submitted as printed and electronic copies (Word-2003 or Word -2007) together with accompanying forms (a letter on the manuscript submission and a document permissive open publication);

authors surnames and initials, institution name, manuscript title, list of references, abstract and key words are submitted also in English;

the abstract should perform the function of a reference tool (for a reader, library and abstracting service) that allows to a reader to understand whether it is reasonable to him to read the full text of the manuscript. The basic components of the abstract are urgency, problem definition and problem solving paths, obtained results, conclusions;

symbols, formulae and continuing similarly should be typed using function "symbol"; the format Math Type should be used only for the expressions, which cannot be typed without this format;

the Greek symbols should be typed with Roman, vectors — without upper arrows, using boldface roman font;

the authors should refrain from application of mixed Russian and Latin indexes; the indexes should be deciphered in brackets or context;

the drawings, diagrams and photographs should be made compactly, in a format ensuring lucidity of all the details understandable; they should be inserted into the text or submitted as separate files (Word-2003, Word-2007 or BMP, JPEG, TIFF, PCX) with indication of figure sequence number;

a figure size across a page should be no less than 8 cm. Numerals on the diagram scales and letterings on the graphic matter field of the Russian-language manuscripts should be typed in Russian, taking into consideration Russian grammar rules, application of capitals at component notation, Russian punctuation marks (decimal commas). It is in preference to carry out letterings into captions;

the author photos (portraits) should be submitted in separate files in formats Word-2003, Word-2007 or BMP, JPEG, TIFF, GIF, PSD and PCX;

the references should contain the following information:

for journal papers:	surnames and initials of authors, journal title, publication year, volume, issue number (not necessarily), pages;
for books:	surnames and initials of authors, full book title, publication place, publishing house, publication year, number of pages;
for papers in transaction and conference proceedings:	surnames and initials of authors, transactions (conference) title, publication city, publisher or publishing institute, publication year, volume, part or issue number (if available), pages;
for theses:	author's surname, initials and academic degree, theme, institute, year of the thesis defence, number of pages;
for patents:	the promulgation place and year, number of the patent abstract journal with imprint;

for preprints:

surnames and initials of authors, publication institution, number, place and year, number of pages;

There is no manuscript publication fee for the author's, inclusive of postgraduate students;

In other respects the authors should be guided by examples of manuscript appearance in our journal;
